In the second episode, the team travel to Cardiff to sort out the wardrobe of opera singer Alys Mererid Roberts, who has recently moved house. But, as well as loving to sing – Alys also loves clothes.

"I have a lot of vintage and second-hand clothes, I have quite a large collection," says Alys. "And since I've moved around a lot lately, that's the thing I need help with more than anything. Once something goes in a box, it's forgotten."
