An exciting new character arrives in Rownd a Rownd

An exciting new character has arrived in Glanrafon, the fictional village of the soap opera Rownd a Rownd. Tammy is a young woman who has started working at the Boatyard but, so far, she has kept everyone at arm's length.

Over the next few months, we will find out a lot more about Tammy – in the meantime, some characters will rub her up the wrong way while others will keep her entertained.

Actor Lois Elenid plays Tammy. She has appeared in the second series of **Craith**, and several short films but this is her first time acting in a soap opera.

Here, the actor who lives in the village of Rhydyclafdy near Pwllheli answers questions about her character and the experience of being part of the cast of **Rownd a Rownd**.

How would you describe Tammy?

She is not a very nice character. Obviously, there are always reasons why people behave the way they do - upbringing is a lot of it. She doesn't let people get close to her emotionally, and she doesn't have a lot of friends. She is a bit of a lone wolf, and she manipulates people too. There is always a reason why she does something.

I'm not sure how her character is going to develop but I think she's starting to bring her guard down. Hopefully she will be able to open up a little bit and be more honest.

Is it fun to play a character like this?

Yes, it is very interesting. I have a lot of fun because I never know what she's going to say next. She is completely different to me and that gives me the opportunity to experiment with the role. She is quite a hands-on character and works in the Boatyard. Her father has taught her to be very practical. Her clothes are quite different to what I would wear as well - lots of combat boots and work trousers.

Have you always been a fan of Rownd a Rownd?

We grew up watching S4C and we have been watching **Rownd a Rownd** every week as a family since I was a child. I would then go to school and chat about what had happened with my friends.

How did it feel to join the cast?



Everyone has been so kind which has really helped to get rid of any nerves. I knew some members of the cast before starting, so that helped to have some connection with them and be able to have conversations in the early days. I've had a warm welcome from everyone and the crew are all great. It's nice to know you can turn to someone if you have questions about the character if you're not sure. I can discuss it with them, and it helps me to be able to get into the role a bit better.
